Procedure:

- Complete the application form;
- Provide a copy of passport;
- including academic references; Provide certified true copies of academic certificates, transcripts, English proficiency qualifications
- Provide a copy of valid health insurance

Visa Requirement and Procedure:

Two (2) documents required: a) Student Visa, and b) Student Pass

UBD's International Student Centre (ISC) will assist all exchange/non-graduating student to apply their passport to UBD at least 2 months before their arrival. Successful visa applicants will initially for student visa and student pass. All successful applicants only need to submit scanned copies of student visa and student pass. be issued entry visa-on-arrival. Thereafter, ISC will proceed to convert this visa-on-arrival to

Note:

-Once their studies have ended in UBD, all exchange/non-graduating students must cancel both the student visa and student pass prior to leaving the university (Student Central can assist on these matters). The cancellation process can take up to two (2) weeks therefore students must plan their departure date accordingly.
