Please note!!

- You CANNOT submit <u>individual credit card receipts</u> or cash receipts claiming tax benefits under a name other than Ajou University.
- To claim tax benefits under the name of the university when making cash payments, you must present the business registration number of the university: 124-82-10324
- Each handwritten receipt cannot exceed the amount of 30,000 won (all handwritten receipts must contain business registration numbers of the sellers

When to submit the receipts

- Fill out the form(Attached-Statement of Accounts) and attach all receipts
- Booth leaders must come to OIA and submit the form by Nov. 12 (Wednesday)
