

<b>Full-time workload</b>	<p>Exchange students usually take 3 to 6 courses per semester based on 3 credits per course. One 3-credit course consists of 48-hour workload.</p> <p>No minimum workload is required. Maximum workload allowed per semester is 19 credits (usually 6~7 courses)</p>																																																																		
<b>Information on courses open to exchange students</b>	<p>Consistent with its emphasis on global education, Ajou University offers a variety of courses taught in English. Currently, more than 300 students from various countries study at Ajou through our student exchange program.</p> <p>At Ajou University, exchange students are enrolled as undergraduate regardless of students' level of studies at their home university.</p> <p>In case students are graduate (master) at their home university, they can take up to 6 credits of graduate (master) courses at Ajou, but should go through a prior approval of each professor. If graduate (master) students take undergraduate courses at Ajou, they should check with their home university if undergraduate credits at Ajou can be transferred or not.</p>

<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Exchange students must be nominated by the Ajou's exchange partner university or through ISEP (International Student Exchange Program).</li> <li>Exchange students must be a full-time student in one of Ajou's exchange partner universities and have completed at least 1 semester of study at home university.</li> <li>Students from a non-partner university should have completed at least 1 semester of study at home university and meet the requirement of above 3.0 /4.5 on GPA and the language proficiency.</li> </ul>
<b>Language requirement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>English: TOEFL IBT 71, CET level 6, IELTS level 6 or equivalent</li> <li>If students do not have an official English score, the recommendation letter by a faculty will be needed to prove the student's English proficiency enough to cope with the curriculum conducted in English.</li> <li>In case exchange students are willing to take courses in Korean at Ajou, they should have above level 3 on TOPIK or equivalent.</li> </ul>

<b>Visa requirements</b>	<p>Students need to obtain the <b>D-2-6 Visa</b> with the admission and invitation letter which will be issued by Ajou.</p>																											
<b>Alien Registration</b>	<p>All students who stay in Korea for more than 90 days must apply for the alien registration card within 90 days of entry. It usually takes 4-5 weeks for the ARC to be issued.</p> <p>On-campus immigration service will be provided for one day in the beginning of the semester for all new foreign students (this is subject to change).</p>																											
<b>Insurance requirements</b>	<p>All exchange students should have a health insurance during their stay in Korea. Students <b>need</b> to purchase health insurance from their home countries, and submit the copy of the certificate to the Office of International Affairs at Ajou before their arrival.</p>																											

<p><b>Health Check-up</b></p>	<p>All students <b>must</b> submit the health and medical clearance form through the online application as part of the required documents.</p> <p>According to the government regulation, students with certain designated nationalities (listed below) will need to submit tuberculosis test result upon their D-2-6 visa application. If students were not asked to submit the result upon visa application, they need to get re-tested for tuberculosis at the district public health center in Korea upon arrival.</p> <p>The 19 <b>designated</b> countries are:</p> <p><i>Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, East Timor, India, Indonesia, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Russia, Sri Lanka, Thailand, The Philippines, Uzbekistan, Vietnam</i></p>
<p><b>Orientation</b></p>	<p>All international students are required to attend the orientation. During the orientation, important information such as academic schedule, alien registration, and tips for living in Korea will be introduced to prepare students for life in Korea.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Orientation schedule (mandatory) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fall 2019 semester : August 29, 2019</li> <li>- Spring 2020 semester : February 27, 2020 (tentative)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Meals and Food</b></p>	<p>Students can buy various types of meals on and off-campus, and also cook some instant snacks in the shared kitchen of the dormitory. Students usually use the kitchen to cook noodles, sandwiches, and small snacks or to keep their own food in the communal refrigerator. Normal meal prices range from 3,500 won to 7,000 won (approx. USD \$ 3~7) per meal.</p>
<p><b>Opening a bank account</b></p>	<p>This is optional. If students would like to open a bank account in Korea, they will need to bring their Alien Registration Card (Alien Registration Card information will be announced during the orientation) and the passport.</p> <p>ISEP students and GKS Exchange students must open a bank account in Korea to receive their meal stipend.</p>
<p><b>Other important information</b></p>	<p>Every fall semester, there is Ajou International Day festival where students present their culture and food, and introduce their school to Ajou. It is a good idea for students to bring traditional displays and costumes to wear them to the festival.</p>
